DIRECTIONS

From the South: Take Route 7N into the center of Williamstown, MA (intersection of Routes 2 and 7 at the Village Green), continue on 7N toward Pownal/Bennington VT for one mile measuring from the split of Route 2East. Bonnie Lea Farm is located at the foot of the bridge, on the left side, the second driveway past the Hemlock Brook Condominiums.

From the North: Take Route 7S into Williamstown, MA, 1.5 miles from the Vermont Line. Proceed over large bridge slowly as the driveway is at the base of the bridge on the right. Continue through the gates toward the barn parking lot.

Class Descriptions

Warm-Up

Un-judged Warm-Up – To be ridden at height of current class. Multiple rounds allowed throughout day. Must inform gate-keeper of warm-up status prior to ring entry. Each

- 1 round is same as standard entry fee. Open all day.

Leadline Division

Open to riders 6 years of age and under who may not have competed in any other class at any recognized show, except for leadline. Adult (over age 18) required to lead entry.

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. No child may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope at any previous show.

Pre Children's/Adult Division 2'

Open to riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3 in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'6". No combinations. Simple changes will not be penalized.

Baby Green Hunter

Open to any horse in their first or second year of showing who has never shown higher than 2'6" in said 1st or 2nd year. Horses that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence heights exceed 2'6". No rider restrictions. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Novice Hunter

Open to any rider who is eligible for novice adult or novice junior equitation as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders who enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at the show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". The course will not include any combinations. Fences not to exceed 2'0".

Pleasure Division

May include Open Pleasure, Road Hack, Bridle Path Hack, Hunter Pleasure. Classes must be open to all horses and ponies. To be shown on the flat only at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. NEHC Pleasure Class: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality, in that order. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact.

Bonnie Lea Farm Equitation Classic

Open to all junior and amateur exhibitors, the classic will be run in two phases. The first phase of the class will be over a course of 8-10 fences ranging in height from 2'6" to 2'9". Following the over fences phase, competitors will be called back for a flat phase. Further testing may be required at the judge's discretion. Eight ribbons will be awarded and the champion and their trainer will each win a tree donated by **Mountain Home Landscape**.

Open to all except professional riders. No horse restrictions. Horse/rider combinations that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at the show in which fence height exceeds 2'6".

Children's Equitation 2'6"

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter Division and who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 3'. Fences for small/medium ponies - 2', fences for large ponies and horses - 2'6". (PHA) Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'6" in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'9". Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'6" with at least one change of direction. No combinations. (MHC/NEHC)

Open to members of MHC who have not reached their fifteenth birthday and have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than three feet. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding eight fences and not less than six fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6" for ponies and horses. One or more individual test may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-8.) To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

Modified Junior Equitation

Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 3' in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'9" with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional.

Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and over. Fences not to exceed 2'9". (PHA) Fences not to exceed 3' (NEHC & MHC).

Open to adult amateur members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set at a height from 2'9" to 3' with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

Adult Amateur Hunter 3' (18-35 years) (over 35 years)

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horse/rider combination is not eligible for any other MHC, NEHC or USEF rated classes. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Height of fences 3' spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by Adults, suitability to count.

Children's Hunter

To be shown by Junior Exhibitors. Junior Exhibitors 15-17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate (limit) equitation over fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences 2' for small and medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, 3' for horses; spreads not to exceed fence height.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Please NO Dogs on the show grounds.
2. Division entry fees will not be refunded after the start of the first class in the division. All scratches must be made directly with the Show Secretary.
3. Each exhibitor, trainer and owner/agent must fill out and sign an official entry blank before numbers will be issued.
4. Management reserves the right to charge double the entry fee to anyone showing in a class they have not entered prior to the start of the class.
5. **Numbers will not be released without a signed entry and open check/valid credit card information.**
6. A processing fee of \$25.00 will be charged on all checks returned by the bank for any reason.

7. All riders must wear protective headgear while riding anywhere on the show grounds.
8. All entries will be accepted with the understanding that the management will not be responsible for any accident, which may occur to any rider, driver, groom, attendants or equipment at the show.
9. The management reserves the right to decline any entry and return the entry fee without being liable for compensation.
10. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel/combine any event that has less than 3 entries.
11. The Officials listed have agreed to officiate. The Show Committee reserves the right to vary these names if unforeseen circumstances require it.
12. All horses must have a negative coggins test.
13. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications in the current WNE-PHA, NEHC and MHC rule books and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith USEF rules.
14. Any rider/horse combination in warm-up will be charged accordingly.
15. Each fully completed entry form for horse/rider combination received by 5:00 pm the Friday night prior to the horse show will be eligible for a drawing for a free day of show entries. One rider will be chosen at random, the morning of the show. The free day of show entries applies only to those entries received prior to 5 pm Friday and not those classes added the day of the show.

Management reserves the right to decline or refuse any entry without being liable for compensation, and eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or horse should the best interest of the show be served.
