

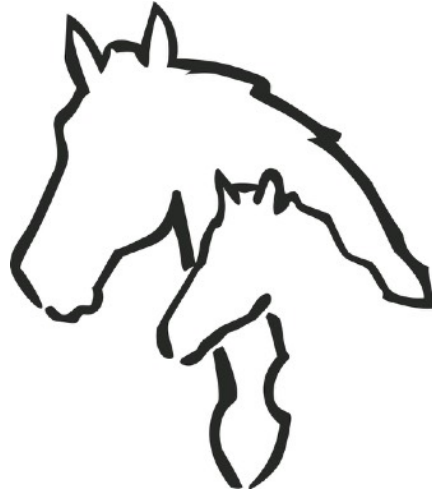

BONNIE LEA FARM SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Please NO Dogs on the show grounds.
2. Division entry fees will not be refunded after the start of the first class in the division. All scratches must be made directly with the Show Secretary.
3. All horses must have proof of a negative coggins test.
4. Each exhibitor, trainer and owner/agent must fill out and sign an official entry blank before numbers will be issued.
5. Management reserves the right to charge double the entry fee to anyone showing in a class they have not entered prior to the start of the class.
6. **Numbers will not be released without a signed entry and open check/valid credit card information.**
7. A processing fee of \$35.00 will be charged on all checks returned by the bank for any reason.
8. All riders must wear appropriate, protective headgear while riding anywhere on the show grounds.
9. All entries will be accepted with the understanding that the management will not be responsible for any accident, which may occur to any rider, driver, groom, attendants or equipment at the show.
10. The management reserves the right to decline any entry and return the entry fee without being liable for compensation.
11. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel/combine any event that has less than 3 entries.
12. The Officials listed have agreed to officiate. The Show Committee reserves the right to vary these names if unforeseen circumstances require it.
13. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications in the current WNE-PHA, NEHC and MHC rule books and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith USEF rules.
14. **Entries must be received by 7:00 pm the Friday night prior to the horse show. Late entries are subject to a \$25 late entry fee.**
15. Show Point values are as follows: 1st=10 pts, 2nd= 6 pts, 3rd=4pts, 4th=2pts, 5th=1 pts, 6th=.5pt.

Class Descriptions

PHA Walk-Trot Division

Open to riders 12 years of age and under who have never shown at the canter. Child may not compete in any other class or division.

Beginner Division

Open to youth riders not ready for short or long stirrup. No child may compete in any other division requiring entries to jump a course. Classes may be divided for canter or require individual canter at the judge's discretion. Horsemanship may include a horsemanship question by judge and will recognize the rider's ability to appropriately handle her/his horse. Beginner Cross-rails is an optional class for division riders according to suitability & safety.

Leadline Division

Open to riders 10 years of age and under who may not have competed in any other class at any recognized show, except for leadline. Adult (over age 18) required to lead entry.

Short Stirrup Equitation (18")

Open to junior/amateur riders 12 and under, who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation/Medal classes where fence height does not exceed 2'. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 18". No combinations or oxers. Simple changes will not be penalized.

Long Stirrup Equitation (18")

Open to junior and amateur riders 13 and older (including amateur adults), who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 18". No combinations or oxers. Simple changes will not be penalized.

Pre Children's/Adult Equitation Division 2'

Open to junior and amateur riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3 in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'3", or jumper classes over .70m. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'. No combinations or oxers. Simple changes will not be penalized. If numbers warrant, Pre-Children's and Pre-Adult Equitation may be run separately at any show including finals.

PreChildren/Adult Hunter

Open to any rider who is eligible for novice adult or novice junior equitation as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders who enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at the show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". The course will not include any combinations. Fences not to exceed 2'0". To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Pleasure Division

May include Open Pleasure, Road Hack, Bridle Path Hack, Hunter Pleasure. Classes must be open to all horses and ponies. To be shown on the flat only at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality, in that order. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact.

Young Hunter In Hand

Young Hunter In Hand class evaluates horses (6 years and under) on their conformation, movement, and suitability to become a hunter. May be asked to trot in hand.

Modified Children's/ Modified Adult Equitation

Open to junior and amateur riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'6 in a recognized show or jumper classes over .80m. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'3". No combinations or oxers. Simple changes will not be penalized. If numbers warrant, Modified Children's and Modified-Adult Equitation may be run separately at any show including finals.

Junior/Amateur Hunter

Horse/rider combinations that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at the show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Children's Equitation 2'6"

Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'6 in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'9" or jumper classes to .85 meters maximum. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'6 with at least one change of direction. No combinations. Ramped oxers permitted.

Adult Equitation 2'6"

Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and over. Fences not to exceed 2'9". (PHA) See Children's Eq.

Modified Junior Equitation 2'9"

Open to junior riders who have never competed Over Fences exceeding 3' in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'9. Combinations are optional.

Junior Equitation (WNE-PHA) 3'

Open to all junior riders who are not eligible for Pre- Children's or Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 3' with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional. Ramped oxers permitted.

Short/Long Stirrup Hunter

Open to all junior/amateur riders, who have never competed over fences exceeding 2', in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 18". No combinations or oxers. Simple changes will not be penalized. If numbers warrant, Short and Long Stirrup may be run separately.

Baby Green Hunter

Open to any horse in their first or second year of showing over fences who has never shown higher than 2'6" in said 1st or 2nd year. Horses that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence heights exceed 2'6". No oxers. No rider restrictions. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. Trotting in corners will not be penalized. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

Pre-Child/Adult Hunter

Open to junior and amateur riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3" in a recognized show or jumper classes over .90m. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'. No combinations or oxers. Simple changes will not be penalized. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. If numbers warrant, Pre-Children's and Adults may be run separately.

Modified Children's/Modified Adult Hunter 2'3"

Open to junior and amateur riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'6" in a recognized show or jump classes over .80m. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'3". No combinations or oxers. Simple changes will not be penalized. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. If numbers warrant, Modified-Children's and Modified- Adults may be run separately.

Low Hunter 2'6"

Open to ALL horse/rider combinations. Fence height not to exceed 2'6". To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Adult Hunter 2'6"

ADULT HUNTER DIVISION - Open to horses ridden by Amateur riders. Fences not to exceed 2'6'. Ramped oxers permitted. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness.

Children's Hunter 2'6"

To be shown by Junior Exhibitors. Junior Exhibitors 15-17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate (limit) equitation Over Fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences 2' for small and medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, 3' for horses; spreads not to exceed fence height. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

LOW, ADULT and CHILDREN'S Hunter may be combined, but rider must indicate the chosen division for year end points.

WNE-PHA Medal Classes

Open to members of the WNEPHA who are eligible for the specific Medal Class/Division. Rider MUST be a member before the class begins. Division specific rules apply for eligibility and requirements. See applicable equitation division descriptions above. Medal courses must have at least 8 fences and one change of direction. A minimum of 3 riders is needed to fill the class. Medal divisions may be run separately if numbers warrant.
