DIRECTIONS

From the South: Take Route 7N into the center of Williamstown, MA (intersection of Routes 2 and 7 at the Village Green), continue on 7N toward Pownal/Bennington VT for one mile measuring from the split of Route 2East. Bonnie Lea Farm is located at the foot of the bridge, on the left side, the second driveway past the Hemlock Brook Condominiums. Continue through the gates toward the barn parking lot.

From the North: Take Route 7S into Williamstown, MA, 1.5 miles from the Vermont Line. Proceed over large bridge slowly as the driveway is at the base of the bridge on the right. Continue through the gates toward the barn parking lot.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Walk Trot- Open to riders 12 and under who have never shown at the canter. May not enter any other division.

Leadline- Open to riders under 10. May not enter any other division.

Short Stirrup- Open to riders 12 and under. Riders may not enter any other division except Pleasure.

Long Stirrup- Open to riders 13 and over. Riders may not enter any other division except Pleasure and Novice Hunter.

Novice Hunter- 2' Open to novice jr. /adult riders. Horse/rider combination may not compete above 2'6" in any class at the show.

Pre-Children's / Adult Eq. - 2' Open to junior riders 14 and under and amateurs who have never shown above 2'3"

Pleasure- To be shown walk, trot, canter both directions of the ring. Judged on manners, performance and suitability.

Baby Green Hunter- 2'3" Open to horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing that have never shown above 2'6". No combinations.

Children's Eq.- 2'6" Open to jr. riders who have never shown above 2'6"

Jr./Amateur Hunter- 2'6" Horse/rider combination may not compete above 2'6" in the show.

Adult Eq.- 2'6"-2'9" Open to adult amateurs. Course may include combinations.

Low Hunter- 2'6" No restrictions.

Modified Jr. Eq.- 2'9" Open to jr. riders who have never shown above 3'.

Junior Eq.- 3' Open to junior riders.

Children's Hunter- 3' horses, 2'6" ponies. May be divided if entries warrant.

Bonnie Lea Farm Equitation Classic - Open to all junior and amateur exhibitors. The classic will be run in two phases. The first phase of the class will be over a course of 8-10 fences, 2'6" – 2'9" in height. Following the over fences phase, competitors will be called back for a flat phase. Further testing may be required at the judge's discretion. 8 ribbons will be awarded and the champion and their trainer will each win a tree donated by Mountain Home Landscape.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Please NO Dogs on the show grounds.
2. Division entry fees will not be refunded after the start of the first class in the division. All scratches must be made directly with the Show Secretary.
3. Each exhibitor or trainer must fill out and sign an official entry blank before numbers will be issued.
4. Management reserves the right to charge double the entry fee to anyone showing in a class they have not entered prior to the start of the class.
5. A processing fee of \$25.00 will be charged on all checks returned by the bank for any reason.
6. All riders must wear protective headgear while riding anywhere on the show grounds.
7. All entries will be accepted with the understanding that the management will not be responsible for any accident, which may occur to any rider, driver, groom, attendants or equipment at the show.
8. The management reserves the right to decline any entry and return the entry fee without being liable for compensation.
9. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel/combine any event that has less than 3 entries.
10. The Officials listed have been invited to officiate. The Show Committee reserves the right to vary these names if circumstances require it.
11. Numbers will not be released without a signed entry and open check.
12. All horses must have a negative coggins test.
13. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications in the current WNE-PHA rule book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith USEF rules.
14. Any rider/horse combination in warm-up/schooling will be charged the warm-up fee accordingly.
15. Each entry form for horse/rider combination received by 5:00 pm the Friday night prior to the horse show will be eligible for a drawing for a free day of show entries. One rider will be chosen at random, the morning of the show. The free day of show entries applies only to those entries received prior to 5 pm Friday and not those classes added the day of the show.
